The nominee should be a person who has made a significant impact on the education of young children, at the school, system or provincial level, in one or more of the following areas:

- organizing and implementing child-centred programs
- providing informed responses to Primary Education issues and/or giving supportive educational leadership;
- fostering an attitude that is flexible, positive, imaginative, committed to the education of young children;
- encouraging and facilitating change, growth and improvement in the education of young children.
